
Finally, a plug for Artsfest. I hope the following note from the Charity Team inspires you to buy a ticket.

Everyone acknowledges that Sutton Coldfield is an affluent area. However, what people perhaps do not realise is the extent of the hidden problems that exist here. Poverty, unemployment and mental illness are all prevalent issues, and working with the Sutton Coldfield Community Hub, I have been taken aback to witness families with such a sought-after postcode who can't afford to feed their children. The Hub provides an incredibly diverse service for families such as these, be it from mentoring, employment advice for parents and support for carers to counselling for anything from low self-esteem to domestic violence. However, the charity is massively over-stretched, and so Vesey has decided to give support via 'Artsfest', our gala evening of entertainment, which is not only a showcase of students' talent but a fantastic opportunity to support such a worthy cause. We hope to see as many of you there as possible at 7.30pm on Thursday 24th September, particularly given the three-course meal included and new deal of two tickets for £30 or one for £20. Not only are we trying to raise as much money as possible for extra staff and training, but we will also be putting the money towards designing and building the Hub a new garden in order to enable more community events to bring closer together the people of Sutton who need it most. 
