The last fortnight has seen Vesey on the move with an excellent trip to Rhineland (thank you to **Mr Gotschel** and the team of staff supporting him), a German exchange and a reconnaissance tour of China by **Mr Bowen** and **Miss Green**, readying ourselves for China 2017.
