Dear Parents/Carers

Happy New Year.

We hope you had a wonderful holiday and are looking forward to a happy 2017. As we start the new term, we welcome **Mrs Sunita Patel** as Teacher of Chemistry, and have two staff in temporary new roles: **Naima Field** as Acting Head of Year 8 (n.field@bishopveseys.bham.sch.uk) and **Ralph Brocklebank** as Acting Head of Chemistry. We also welcome our new Parent Governor elected by the parent body, **Mr Andy O'Brien**. I know that Mr O'Brien will have a lot to offer the school in his new role. Also, starting from next Tuesday 10 January we are employing the services of a Careers Advisor for one day per week, **Pauline Knowles**. I am sure this will be a very good additional support for our senior students in particular.

As we start the new year we note the fact that we have good levels of attendance of 96% Year 7-11 and 95.7% Sixth Form. However, our target is 98% as we believe there is a strong correlation between attendance and academic performance.

This is probably a good time to re-state our policy as a school relating to term time absence and holidays. There are very important reasons why students should not take time away from school:

1. School holidays, but particularly summer holidays, offer ample opportunity to take a family holiday. It is very hard to justify taking additional time away from school in addition to these opportunities to go away as a family.
2. Significant absence from school damages a student's progress. Before applying for lengthy absence, families must ask themselves how they plan to address the difficulties that a student's absence from school will cause.
3. Term time holidays often prove a distraction in the period before and after they are taken. Such absences can have an unsettling effect on students which can further hinder their progress.

There of course can be exceptional circumstances that necessitate holidays during term time. However, they remain exactly that, exceptional and not the norm. I would therefore urge all parents to think very carefully before considering absence during term time.

We have again made it through to the West Midlands Real Business Challenge Regional Final. The team members from Y10 are: **Jaden Lo-Watson, Ibrahim Aliwi, Harvey Quinn, Aidan Towse, Luke O'Brien, Freddie Goodrham** and **Raul Athwall** and they have been working on the Coca-Cola Enterprises Real Business Challenge (RBC). Thanks to Dr Reilly for his support and mentoring expertise with the team.


We are legally required to submit information to the Department for Education (DfE) as part of our Termly School Census Return. The DfE have requested the following information for each pupil at the School:

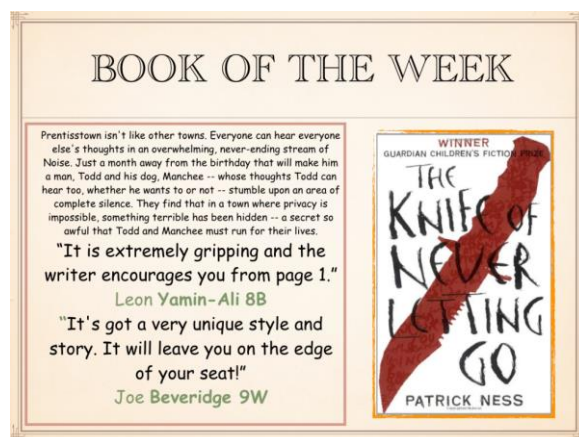
