
Hope not Hate

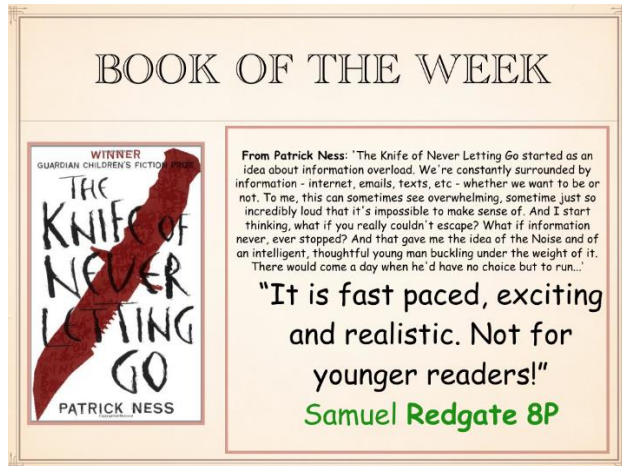
