

BYOD access Android devices instructions.

In order to access the BYOD system you will need to carry out the following two steps.

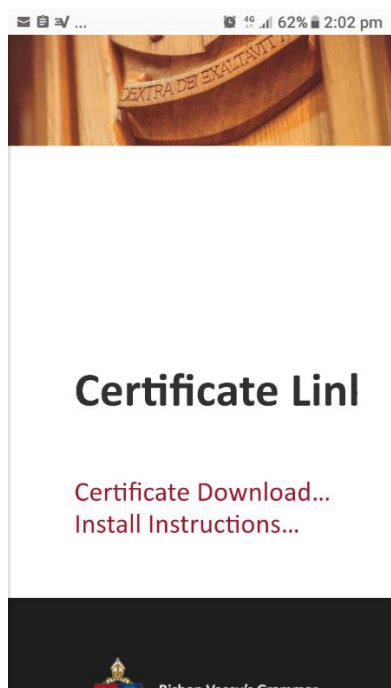
- 1 install the BGFL certificate.
- 2 connect to the School's BYOD Wireless.

Step 1 will need to be completed using your 3/4G connection or at home when connected to your wireless.

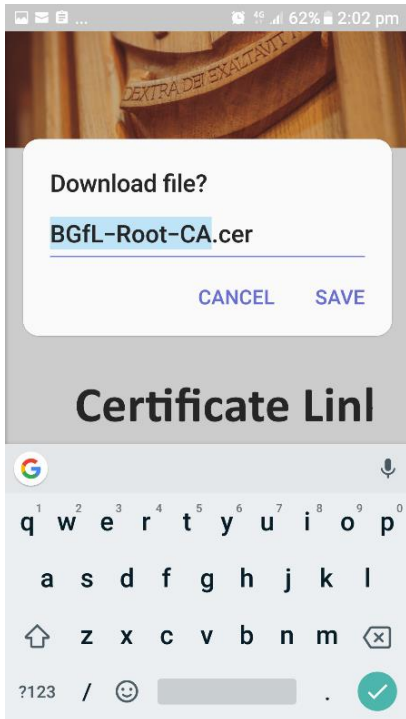
Step 1 How to install the BGFL certificate

In order for BGFL to scan for inappropriate content in SSL encrypted traffic you will need to install certificate issued by BGFL before you can use the BVGS BYOD system. The instructions below explain the process of how to install the certificate and connect the BYOD network.

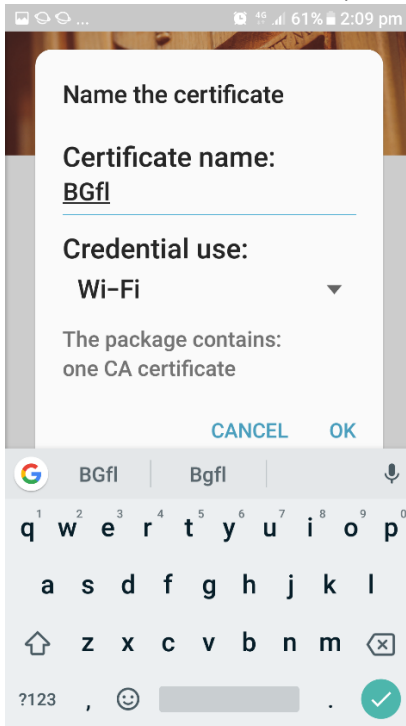
Open up the web browser and go to www.bvgs.co.uk/cert-link which will take you to this page where you need to click Certificate Download.



Click save.



Name the certificate BGfL, set the credentials to **Wi-Fi** and click ok.



You should now receive confirmation that the certificate has installed.

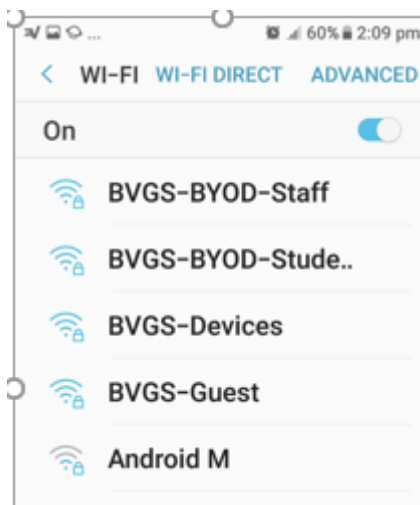
Step 2 Connecting to the the school BYOD wireless Network.

Step two will need to be completed whilst in school.

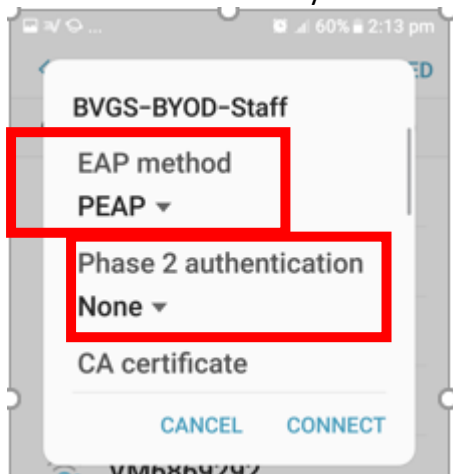
Firstly, turn on your wireless and click the relevant wireless SSID.

- **Staff** are only permitted to access *BVGS-BYOD -Staff*.
- **Students** are only permitted to access *BVGS_BYOD-Student*.
