Gatsby Benchmarks – 1.Stable Careers programme

Year 9's career programme is delivered during form time. Each session happens once a fortnight on a Tuesday during extended registration time. Students are issued an exercise book and folder to evidence the work they are doing in form. Students upload evidence to UNIFROG where appropriate.

All students will have the opportunity to complete **psychometric testing** during form time to gather information about themselves and how this data can inform future careers.
